BYLAWS AND REGULATIONS

ARTICLE III

Apprentices and Pre-Registrants

Section 1. APPRENTICES

Section Apprentice status may be granted to those persons who have been accepted as Association Apprentice registrants. (See Association Bylaws, Article III)

Section 2. Pre-APPRENTICES

Section Pre-Apprentice status may be granted to individuals who are eligibly employed as defined by Association Bylaws and looking to enter the Association Golf Professional Training Program.

- (a) This is a one-time, two-year membership affiliation with the Section. At the end of two years, a Pre-Apprentice must have passed the Association Playing Ability Test and registered in the G.P.T.P. or will be removed from the Section membership rolls.
- (b) Pre-Apprentices are granted opportunity to play in Assistant Association and selective Section events, participate in Section Education programs and attend Section Meetings upon payment of any required fees.
- (c) Pre-Apprentices are required to attend a *Pre-Apprentice Initiation* in order to receive Section privileges.
